- 1) Each Bowling Center within the jurisdictional area of the Memphis Area USBC Association, Inc. may conduct its own tournament between and including: January 17, 2025 through February 7, 2025.
- All bowlers bowling within that Bowling Center will compete in squads at the time and on the day decided by the Management. <u>Minimum of four (4) pairs per squad.</u>
- 3) All **USBC youth bowlers** within the jurisdictional area of the Memphis Area USBC Association, Inc. are eligible and must bowl in the Center in which they are members of a certified league.
- 4) AGE DIVISIONS: Bantam 8 and Under Prep 9-11 Junior 12-14 Senior 15-18 All bowlers must bowl in his or her own age group. Age is determined as of August 1, 2024. There can be no substitutes for any youth bowler in the city-wide roll-off. Adult substitutes must be of same gender.
- 5) USBC Youth bowlers may enter twice only, once with a man & once with a woman. Non-parents may enter twice only, once with a boy and once with a girl. However, a parent may enter as many times as necessary to bowl with each of his or her youth. Parents may elect to bowl with more than one (1) of his or her youths at the same time. Each entry must consist of one (1) USBC certified youth bowler and one (1) adult bowler with entry fee.
- 6) Average: USBC youth bowlers must use their highest certified league average as of December 8, 2024 with a minimum of three (3) league sessions. USBC youth bowlers with no December 8, 2024 average but have three (3) league sessions by the date he or she bowls in the Center level tournament may enter with handicap. USBC youth members not meeting the average rule may enter but must bowl scratch using a 200 average. Adult bowlers must use their highest 2023-2024 USBC certified average. If an adult bowler has no 2023-2024 certified average, he or she may use their highest current 2024-2025 certified league average of 21 games or more as of date entered & must submit a current standing sheet. Adults without a USBC certified average may enter but must bowl scratch. USBC rule 319a 1 3 4 & 5 will apply. Rule 319 d & e will not apply. Adults not USBC certified must pay an associate membership fee of \$27 or pay an adult participation fee of \$5. Fees along with a completed USBC adult membership card must accompany entry. Youth bowlers who have gone adult MUST provide a current standing sheet. STANDING SHEETS MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES! CENTERS MUST VERIFY AVERAGES!
- 7) Bowlers will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes as in league play.
- 8) Handicap: 100% of 200 for both youth and adults.
- 9) Awards: Awards will be given to 1st place winners in all four (4) AGE DIVISIONS, BOTH YOUTH AND ADULT. Youth will receive \$50 scholarships (SMART) and youth and adults will receive towels.
- 10) Inappropriate behavior or non-compliance with any rule while participating in the tournament will be considered grounds for disqualification. Bowlers are required to wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament. Short shorts, work out clothes, midriffs, halter, or tank tops will not be allowed. Pants must be worn at waist level with a belt and skirts/skorts must be knee length. Clothing or bowling equipment with tobacco or alcohol advertising will not be allowed. Hats may not be worn by any participant. Bowlers are not allowed to usetobacco or (Electronic) E-Cigarette products while participating in this tournament. Electronic devices may not be used by any bowler during the tournament. <u>ADULTS - NO ALCOHOLIC</u> <u>BEVERAGES PERMITTED DURING TOURNAMENT!!</u>

No personal checks or cash will be accepted. No money will be returned after receipt by Tournament Manager. All returned checks will be subject to a \$35 return check fee.

- 12) Entry <u>MUST</u> be filled out completely or entry will be placed at bottom of list until information is received.
- 13) This tournament is USBC certified. Rules not covered will be decided by the Tournament Committee or USBC rules

governing tournament play. Decisions by the Tournament Manager are final.
